Friday Local Diesel OEM Truck- \$25 hook fee/ 6:30 pm registration deadline

- 1. Maximum weight of 9000lbs including driver.
- 2. Trucks must be stock in appearance.
- 3. Trucks must have stock turbo(s).
- 4. Aftermarket intakes ARE allowed.
- 5. No added weights will be permitted. Tool boxes (if emptied) and snow plow mounts are acceptable.
- 6. Functional flatbeds ARE allowed.
- 7. Must have a Reese style hitch and hitch height must not exceed 26" from ground at hitch point.
- 8. Tire size is limited to 35" or less.
- 9. <u>MUST</u> have a working kill switch installed. NO EXCEPTIONS (test will be performed before hooking to sled)
 - a. For convenience, a sample wiring diagram is included

Friday Local Street Diesel- \$25 hook fee/ 6:30 pm registration deadline

- 1. Maximum weight of 9000lbs including driver.
 - a. Vehicle must have a full body.
- 2. Weights are allowed in <u>BED ONLY</u> and must be properly secured prior to hooking to sled.
- 3. Engine compartments are limited to stock appearance.
- 4. Must have a Reese style hitch and hitch height must not exceed 26" from ground at hitch point.
- 5. Must have street legal State registration.
- 6. NO solid suspensions allowed.
- 7. NO cut tires allowed.
- 8. Aftermarket intakes ARE allowed.
- 9. Nitrous Oxide, Propane, and Water Injection are prohibited.
- 10. <u>MUST</u> have a working kill switch installed. NO EXCEPTIONS (test will be performed before hooking to sled)
 - a. For convenience, a sample wiring diagram is included


Saturday Local Semi Rules

1. Pulling tractors/trucks must be out of the pit area immediately following the event to ensure timely setup for main event.

- 2. All entries must be registered by 6:30 pm on the day of the event.

Sample Kill Switch Wiring Diagram



- Switch must be of a "Break-Away" style, which attaches to pulling sled by cable or cord and kills power to engine in the event of a hitch failure.
- Switch must be located at rear of pulling equipment and pass functional inspection before hooking to sled.
- Operator assumes sole responsibility for switch failure or equipment damage.
